As a part of Undocumented Student Action Week, Redwood City Together, Redwood City 2020's welcoming initiative, hosted a community dialogue at Cañada College on Tuesday, October 15. The event was in partnership with the Promise Scholars Program, which provides incoming full-time students financial and academic support for two years.

Both students and faculty engaged in the dialogue. Using silhouette art and 6-word memoirs created by Sequoia High School DREAM Club students as a catalyst for conversation, participants shared personal stories of resilience and hardship around their immigrant journeys and reflected on avenues of support at Cañada College. At the end of the dialogue, each participant made an action commitment towards building empathy, understanding, and supportive action in Redwood City and North Fair Oaks!
