COVID-19 Relief Fund Application Assistance: Bilingual Volunteers Needed

Redwood City 2020 is coordinating a volunteer effort to help individuals and families in need apply online for the [City of Redwood City's COVID-19 Relief Fund Program](#) on behalf of Fair Oaks Community Center. The program is managed by the Fair Oaks Community Center and is intended to help households who have experienced a loss of income due to COVID-19 and have no other alternative sources of income, such as paid leave or unemployment insurance.

With training and guidance from Redwood City 2020 and Fair Oaks Community Center staff, volunteers are helping over 95 individuals and families overcome technological barriers and navigate the COVID-19 Relief Fund Program application process.

We are currently seeking additional bilingual (English-Spanish) volunteers. If you are interested in joining this volunteer effort please contact Redwood City 2020 at ruc2020@gmail.com.
